

How to connect an lc fiber optic connector

Step 4: Insert the Fiber into the LC Connector Carefully align the cleaved fiber with the zirconia ferrule inside the LC connector. For epoxy-based connectors, inject a small amount of fast-curing epoxy into the rear of the connector before insertion. For crimp-style connectors, use the appropriate hand tool to secure the fiber in place. Slowly rotate the ferrule if needed to guide the fiber through the ferrule bore without breaking it.

Step 5: Polish the Connector Tip Polish the connector tip using fiber optic polishing film to achieve a smooth, angled finish. Inspect under a microscope to ensure there are no scratches or defects. Proper polishing maximizes contact area and minimizes insertion loss.
