

How to connect an optical cable to an optical module

Verify port activity using LEDs or diagnostic commands to confirm proper installation.

Step 4: Connect the Optical Cable Align the fiber connector with the module port. Insert the connector gently until it clicks or seats firmly. Avoid excessive force. If disconnecting for maintenance, replace the dust cap on both the module and the cable to prevent contamination.

Step 5: Test the Connection Use network testing tools to verify signal integrity and link performance. Check for intermittent connectivity or high loss, which may indicate dirty connectors or incompatible modules.
