

How to connect two VLANs to one interface on an access switch



Overview

This option is called router on a stick (ROAS) and allows all VLANs to communicate through a single interface. Use a Layer3 switch, a device that performs both the switching and routing operations. I'm trying to configure a small business switch SG300-10P to do the following: Allow internet connectivity to all other ports (1 to 24) without affecting existing network or DHCP on these 8 ports. So I tried to configure 2 VLANs, VLAN-1 on port 1 to 8, and VLAN-2 on port 9 to 10. Inter-VLAN routing makes communication possible between them, which is important in networks that use VLANs to keep traffic organized, faster, and more secure. For.
