- Including internal cable clamps (one allowance for all clamps).
- Adding double allowances for device yokes (switches, receptacles) connected inside the box.

Summing the volumes of all conductors and devices to determine the minimum cubic inch volume required for the box.

**Step 4: Select an Appropriate Distribution Box** Choose a box that provides enough terminals and volume for all conductors, devices, and future expansion. Consider environmental factors such as moisture, dust, or temperature extremes, and select a box with the...
