

How to install a fiber optic cable to the home

Fiber type: Multimode (OM3/OM4) is cost-effective for distances under 300 meters; single-mode (OS2) is ideal for long distances or future-proofing.

Step 3: Preparing Tools and Safety Equipment Essential tools include a fiber stripper, cleaver, splicing device, and fiber optic connectors. Protective gear like gloves and safety glasses is recommended to handle delicate glass fibers safely.

Step 4: Routing and Securing the Cable Run the fiber along the planned path, using conduits or cable trays where necessary. Secure the cable every few feet to prevent sagging or sharp bends. For outdoor installations, you may bury the cable in a conduit or use aerial mounting. Micro-trenching is an alternative for shallow, narrow trenches that reduce installation time.

Step 5: Termination and Connection Terminate the fiber with appropriate connectors and splice fibers if needed. Connect the cable to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts light signals into data your devices can use...
