

How to install a household electrical distribution box by running cables

Select wire gauge according to circuit amperage: 14 AWG for 15A, 12 AWG for 20A, 10 AWG for 30A, etc. ().

Step 5: Preparing Wires Strip insulation to the correct length for terminal connections. Identify wires by color: black/red for hot, white for neutral, green/bare for ground (). Ensure wires are not frayed and are long enough to reach terminals without tension.

Step 6: Connecting Terminals Connect wires to the distribution box following the principle: phase wire to phase terminal, neutral to neutral bar, ground to ground bar. Tighten...
