 - Rack Mounting:** Install brackets on both sides of the box and secure them to the designated rack position with screws, ensuring the installation direction meets network design requirements.
- Introducing and Routing Fiber Cables** Feed the optical cables into the box through the cable inlet, using grommets to secure them. Use pre-terminated branch fiber jumpers or pigtails. Ensure the fiber length allows the front panel to be fully extended without tension, maintaining a minimum bend radius to prevent damage. Use cable ties and movable clips to organize fibers and maintain proper routing.
