

How to install plastic baffles in a distribution box

Loop the wire around the crossrunner at predetermined locations and secure it through the adjustable fastener. Ensure the baffle is level and properly suspended. Trim excess wire with wire cutters once the baffle is securely in place. Connecting Multiple Baffles If multiple baffles are required, connect crossrunners using the provided connectors and push the systems together to form a continuous assembly. Cap the ends of the baffle system using supplied end caps to prevent airflow or material leakage. Safety and Tips Installation typically requires two people for proper handling and alignment. Wear gloves, safety glasses, and a dust mask if working in confined or dusty spaces. Ensure baffles are firmly se...
