

How to install the steel wire in the optical cable splice box

The steel wire (strength member) in an optical cable splice box is installed by preparing the cable, securing the steel tube, grounding, and sealing the cable entry to ensure mechanical stability and fiber protection.

Step 1: Cable Preparation Leave a sufficient length of cable (typically 3 meters) for preparation and splicing at the splice box location. Wrap self-adhesive sealing tape between the two sealing rings to form a sealed cable end.

Step 3: Securing the Steel Wire Slide the cable retainer over the stainless steel tube and secure it in place, ensuring the steel wire is held rigidly. Use a throat hoop or cable clamp to pass through the reinforcing rib fixing seat and cable core bracket, then tighten the screws to firmly secure the cable. Tie a nylon cable tie around the cable and cut off any excess length to prevent movement.

Step 4: Fiber Handling and Splicing Coil the optical fibers (typically 1.5 turns) and secure them in the splice tray using nylon ties. For single-core fibers, use a single-core buffer tube; for ribbon fibers, use a ribbon buffer tube. Perform fiber splicing according to the prescribed method, coiling any excess fiber in the tray. Cover the fusion splice tray and lock it in place, stacking trays as required by the splice box capacity.
