Step 3: Configure Router Settings Access the router admin panel via a web browser, typically at 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1. Enter ISP credentials provided during installation. Update firmware to ensure the router has the latest security patches and performance improvements. Set Wi-Fi security with a strong password and choose a network name (SSID). Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP, video calls, or gaming to prioritize critical traffic.

Step 4: Optimize and Maintain Your Network Position the router centrally in your home for better Wi-Fi coverage. Monitor network performance using the router's dashboard to check speeds, connected devices, and potential bottlenecks. Regularly reboot the router and ONT if you experience connectivity issues.
