A pair of conductors showing near-zero voltage between them may indicate the same phase, but verification with proper tools is recommended . Separate Neutral and Ground In a subpanel, the neutral bus must be isolated from the ground bus to prevent parallel paths for return current. Only the main panel should bond neutral and ground . Install Circuit Breakers Install breakers in the subpanel according to the load requirements. Each breaker should correspond to a specific circuit, and the total load should not exceed the subpanel's rating . Test Before Energizing After wiring, verify all connections, phase...
