Inspect interconnections and splice points for corrosion or loose connections, as these can compromise safety over time. Proper grounding also helps prevent electrical hazards in case of cable insulation failure. Heat Dissipation and Environmental Protection Use perforated or mesh trays to allow airflow and prevent heat accumulation, which can degrade cable insulation. For outdoor or corrosive environments, select trays made of stainless steel, aluminum alloy, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic to resist moisture, UV, and chemical damage
