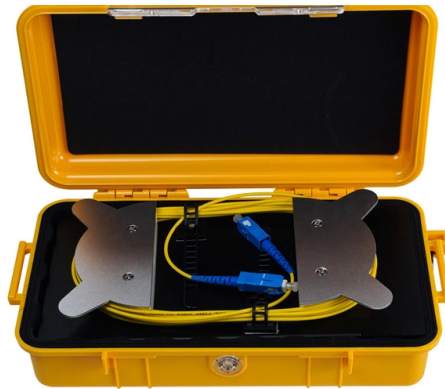


How to set up a router after installing fiber optic internet
