

How to test if a pigtail cable has internet speed

A modern Gigabit cable should show 1000/1000 Mbps. Lower speeds (e.g., 100/100 Mbps) may indicate a cable limitation.

Step 3: Test Actual Data Transfer Speed To measure the cable's performance between devices:

- iPerf3 method:** Connect two computers to the same network using the cable. Install iPerf3 on both machines. On one computer, run `iperf3 -s` (server). On the other, run `iperf3 -c [server IP]` (client). iPerf3 will report bandwidth; a Gigabit cable should achieve around 940 Mbps. Significantly lower results indicate a bottleneck, likely due to the cable.

Step 4: Optional Online Speed Test While online tests (e.g., Ookla Speedtest) measure your internet speed rather than the cable itself, they can help confirm that the cable is not limiting your connection when plugged directly into the router.

Step 5: Troubleshooting Swap the cable with a known good one to isolate issues. Re-terminate connectors if the cable is homemade or damaged. Avoid long runs o...
