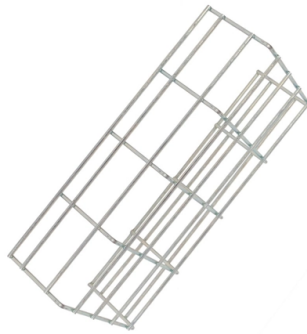


How to typically configure a core switch

Backplane Bandwidth Consideration: Ensure the switch's backplane can handle the expected inter-port traffic to avoid bottlenecks.

Advanced Features

- Spanning Tree Protocol (STP):** Enable STP to prevent loops in the network and maintain redundancy.
- Quality of Service (QoS):** Configure QoS policies to prioritize critical traffic and optimize performance.
- Port Security and ACLs:** Restrict unauthorized access and control traffic flow using access control lists.
- Redundancy and High Availability:** Implement redundant links and switch stacking or VRRP/HSRP for failover.
- Monitoring and Maintenance:** NetFlow or SNMP: Enable traffic monitoring and logging to track performance and detect anomalies.
- Regular Backups:** Save configuration files and maintain versioned backups for disaster recovery.
