Polish Type: UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) affects signal reflection and insertion loss; match the polish type to your network requirements .

Installation and Handling

Clean Connectors: Always clean fiber ends with a lint-free wipe or fiber cleaning tool to prevent signal loss .

Avoid Bending: Do not bend the cord beyond its minimum bend radius; excessive bending can cause attenuation or breakage .

Proper Routing: Route cords along cable trays or racks without kinks or sharp turns. Use cable management clips to prevent strain .

Plug and Play: Insert connectors gently into the device ports until they click or lock. Ensure proper alignment to avoid damage .

Labeling: Label both ends of the patch cord for easy identification and troubleshooting in high-density setups .
