5. Installation Considerations: Ensure the pathway is clear of sharp edges or obstacles. For armored or heavier fiber cables, confirm that the conduit or tubing diameter accommodates the cable without excessive compression. Avoid pulling ca...

At the completion of a day's installation, protect bare cable ends by placing a cable cap on the end of the cable, followed by several wraps of tape around each cap.

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Optical Fiber Routing and Bundling

During the hardware installation, cut the corrugated pipe to the desired length and wrap the sharp ends with adhesive tape to protect the optical fiber. Avoid forcibly pulling or excessively bending optical
