1. Verify Module Certification Always use Huawei-certified optical modules to ensure transmission reliability and service stability. Certified modules are labeled with "HUAWEI," and you can verify certification using commands like `display elabel`, `display version`, or `display transceiver` on the switch. Non-certified modules may cause network issues and are not supported by Huawei.
2. Check Fiber Compatibility Multimode gigabit modules must be used with multimode fiber (OM2 or higher). Do not mix single-mode and multimode fibers, as this can prevent the link from functioning. The eSFP-GE-SX-MM850 module uses LC duplex connectors and operates at a center wavelength of 850 nm, supporting distances up to 550 meters over OM2 fiber.
3. Install the Module Insert the SFP module into the switch port with the LC connector facing the correct orientation. Ensure the module is hot-swappable, so the switch does not need to be powered down. For QSFP+ modules, keep the top side with the L-shaped notch upward when inserting.
4. Configure and Monitor the Port Check the port status using: `display interface xgigabitethernet0/0/2` (replace with your port number) to see if the port is administratively up or down. Verify optical power and diagnostics with: `display transceiver interface xgigabitethernet0/0/2 verbose` to monitor received/transmitted power, wavelength, and module health. Ensure the module speed matches the interface; do not use a 10G module on a 1G port.
5. Troubleshooting Tips Perform a loopback test by connecting the fiber jumper to the same module to check for abnormal conditions. Confirm that the transmit and receive optical power are within normal ranges. Avoid using modules with incompatible specifications, such as mismatched wavelengths or single-fiber BIDI m...
