The Huijue FTTx-ODF 96 core is designed for fiber optic cable management, forming and distributing the local backbone optical cable in optical fiber communication systems. It provides functions such as resource management, transmission routing, and protective splicing, but it does not perform Layer 3 switching, routing, or network traffic management like a core switch does.

Key Difference Huijue ODF: Passive optical device for fiber management, no switching or routing capabilities. Core Switch (Huawei/Ruijie): Active network device for routing, switching, and managing high-speed traffic in enterprise or data center networks.

Conclusion The Huijue FTTx-ODF 96 core cannot be used as a core switch. If your goal is to build a high-performance network backbone, you should consider dedicated core switches from vendors like Huawei or Ruijie, which are designed for Layer 3 routing, high throughput, and network resilience. The Huijue device is suitable only for fiber distribution and management within an optical network infrastructure.
