

IP waterproof rating standard for distribution boxes



Overview

IP65: Protection against water jets (12.5 L/min at 30 kPa) from any angle. The IEC has developed the ingress protection (IP) ratings, which grade the resistance of an enclosure against the intrusion of dust or liquids. Electric and electronic equipment deteriorate or malfunction when water or dust enters the device. It replaces vague marketing terms like "waterproof" or "dustproof" with a precise, testable standard. The code looks like IP66. The IP code per IEC 60529 (identical to EN 60529) specifies how well an electrical enclosure or device is protected against the ingress of solid foreign objects, dust and water. The two digits are internationally binding — from junction boxes to industrial computers. Polyurethane (PUR): High mechanical strength, tear resistance.
