Secure cables: Use internal clips or cable ties to prevent movement and stress on fibers.

3. Preparing and Routing Fibers
Strip and cleave fibers: Carefully remove the outer jacket, buffer, and coating using a fiber stripper. Make a clean, perpendicular cut with a fiber cleaver and clean the ends to remove dust or debris.
Manage bending radius: Use bending radius control clips to prevent sharp bends that can cause signal loss or fiber breakage.
Route fibers to adapters or splice trays: Ensure fibers are organized and labeled for easy identification and maintenance.
