

Install the socket into the distribution box

Use the correct wire gauge based on the circuit load: typically 2.5mm² for lighting and socket circuits, and 4.0mm² for air conditioning circuits (). Follow standard color coding: blue for neutral, yellow/green for ground, and red, yellow, or green for phase wires.

Step 4: Connect the Socket to the Distribution Box Connect the line (phase) wire from the distribution box to the socket's live terminal. Connect the neutral wire to the socket's neutral terminal. Connect the ground wire to the socket's grounding terminal. Ensure all connections are tight and secure, using a wire stripper or screwdriver as needed ().

Step 5: Secure and Label Route the wires neatly inside the socket box and distribution box, securing them with cable ties. Leave space for heat dissipation and avoid sharp edges. Label each circuit clearly for future maintenance and troubleshooting ().
