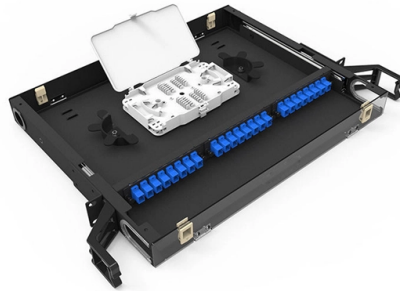


Installation height of outdoor AP distribution box

- Safety and compliance:** Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or national standards) and use UL/CE-certified enclosures with appropriate IP/NEMA ratings for outdoor use.
- Accessibility:** Leave sufficient space around the box for ventilation, inspection, and maintenance.
