Connection Points: Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the distribution box to the mounting plate. Then connect a second wire from the mounting plate to the central factory or building grounding point.

Resistance Requirements: Ensure the total ground resistance between all system parts is less than 0.1 Ohm for industrial systems, or less than 25 Ohms for general building grounding.
