Use wires of appropriate gauge to handle the expected load, and secure them neatly with cable ties to prevent tangling or contact with sharp edges . Install circuit breakers or fuses according to the load requirements, and label each circuit clearly for future maintenance . Mounting the Cover Plate Align the cover plate with the box, ensuring all openings match the installed devices (switches, outlets, or blank spaces). Secure the cover plate using the provided screws, tightening them evenly to avoid warping or gaps .
