

Installation of double-row distribution box panel

Pre-Installation Preparation

Fixing the enclosure: Use the provided studs and adjustable nuts to secure the panel assembly. Ensure the panel is level and firmly anchored to the wall or mounting frame.

Clearance: Maintain sufficient space around the panel for wiring, maintenance, and future expansion.

Electrical Connections

Incoming supply: Connect the main incoming device (MCB, MCCB, or switch disconnecter) according to the manufacturer's instructions. Ensure the busbar is properly aligned and shrouded for safety.

Outgoing circuits: Mount MCBs or RCDs on the DIN rails. Double-row panels allow staggered placement for easier access and wiring. Use aluminum profiles with plastic clips for self-aligning outgoing devices.

Cable management: Route cables neatly, secure with clamps, and maintain proper separation between live, neutral, and earth conductors. Use gland plates or knockouts for cable entry.

Grounding and Safety

Protective earthing: Connect the panel's metal enclosure to the main earth busbar. Ensure all metallic parts are bonded.
