

Installation sequence of various switches in the distribution box

Switches in a distribution box are installed systematically, with the main switch controlling the entire supply and individual circuit breakers protecting each circuit, all connected via busbars and properly grounded.

Main Switch Installation The main switch or main MCB is installed at the top or designated position in the distribution box. It controls the entire electrical supply and allows complete disconnection during maintenance or emergencies. For domestic single-phase systems, a double-pole MCB rated around 63A is commonly used, connecting both the phase and neutral lines from the incoming supply. This ensures that when the main switch is turned on, power is distributed to all downstream circuits.

Circuit Breaker Placement Single-pole MCBs are installed for individual output circuits such as lighting, outlets, or small appliances, while double-pole MCBs may be used for high-power loads like water heaters or air conditioners. Each breaker is mounted on the busbar, which distributes current from the main switch to the individual breakers. Breakers can be plug-in type or bolt-on type, depending on the panel design. Proper spacing and labeling of each breaker are essential for easy identification and maintenance.

Wiring Connections Phase wires from the main switch are connected to the busbar, which then feeds each MCB. Neutral wires are connected to a neutral busbar, and earth wires are connected to an earth bar for grounding. Each output circuit is connected to its respective breaker, ensuring that overcurrent or short-circuit conditions will trip the breaker and protect the circuit.

Protective Devices RCCBs or RCDs are installed to protect against leakage currents, electrical shocks, and insulation failures. They are usually placed after the main switch and before the individual MCBs to provide comprehensive protection.
