3. Prepare the Cable Some invisible cables, like butterfly-type micro-cables, may require stripping the outer protective layer before installation . Ensure the cable is ready for insertion into the adhesive tool or kit.
4. Apply Adhesive or Use a Fiber Kit
- Hot Melt Glue Method:** Insert the cable into the slot of a hot melt glue gun, preheat, and slowly advance the tool along the planned route. Use corner protectors on bends to maintain a minimum bending radius of about 5mm and press the cable firmly for close adhesion .
- DIY Fiber Kits:** Kits like InvisiLight or Invisalite include ultra-thin, bend-insensitive fiber, adhesive, and installation tools. Temporarily secure the fiber with tape or clips, then apply the provided glue to fix it permanently. The fiber can be painted over to match the surrounding surface for complete invisibility .
5. Manage Bends and Corners Use corner protectors to avoid sharp bends that could degrade signal quality. Maintain a steady pace during laying, around 2.5 cm per second, to ensure even adhesion .
6. Connect the Cable After laying, connect the cable ends to terminal devices using quick connectors, cold connectors, or fusion splicing if equipment is available . Ensure connections are secure and signal transmission is stable.
