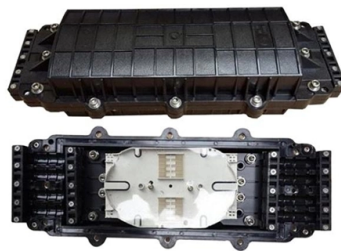

It remains effective down to -45°C (-50°F) and is compatible with common fiber optic jackets. The gel is applied using a high-pressure pump and hose, and conduit ends are sealed to maintain protection while allowing future access.
