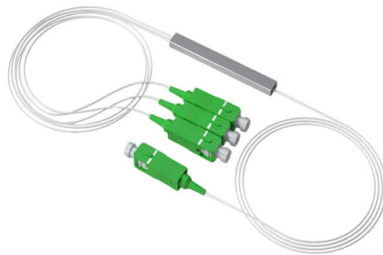

The optical fiber connector is a kind of detachable passive optical component used. Designed to unleash high-speed data center capabilities, MPO Cable Assemblies and Adapters use high-density MTP and MPO-style connectors to deliver streamlined connectivity, high port density, superior loss performance and simplified maintenance for the high-bandwidth networks of tomorrow. These connectors are found primarily in data center environments for consolidating multiple fibers in backbone cabling and supporting parallel optics applications that transmit and receive. MPO stands for 'Multi-Fiber Push On'. Unlike fiber splicing, which is permanent, connectors allow for easy connection and disconnection of cables, making them ideal for maintenance and flexibility in. MPO (Multi-Position Optical) and MTP® (Multifiber Termination Push-on) Connectors are essentially the same, with MTP® being a branded version of MPO.
