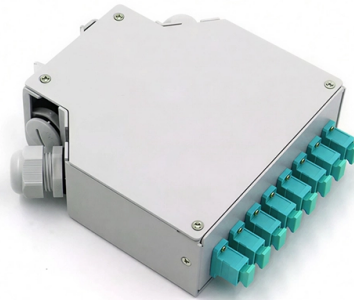

Each breaker protects its respective circuit and allows controlled distribution to specific areas or devices.
