

Monaco Fiber Optic Communication Chip Project



AI Overview

Monaco has achieved full fiber-optic coverage and is exploring advanced digital infrastructure, while European initiatives like SpikeHERO and STARLight are pioneering AI and photonic chips for high-speed optical networks. Monaco's Fiber Optic Infrastructure Monaco completed 100% fiber-optic broadband coverage in 2023 under the Extended Monaco program, retiring copper DSL entirely. Monaco Telecom, the principal provider, offers residential speeds from 100 Mbps to 10 Gbps, with business services reaching up to 10 Gbps and symmetric uploads up to 2 Gbps. The compact 2 km² territory allows fiber access to nearly every building, supporting ultra-fast internet for homes, offices, and commercial centers. Monaco also achieved full 5G coverage by 2025, complementing fiber networks and enabling advanced applications like IoT, autonomous vehicles, and telehealth.

AI and Photonic Chip Initiatives in Europe

While Monaco itself has not publicly launched a dedicated fiber optic communication chip project, European research provides relevant context:

SpikeHERO: Led by Fraunhofer IIS, this EU-funded project (2025–2029) develops AI chips based on spiking neural networks to enhance fiber optic signal quality and data rates. The hybrid optical-electrical chips continuously monitor and correct interference, enabling higher bandwidths and lower latency for future 6G networks. Partners include Fraunhofer EMFT, Eindhoven University of Technology, Hewlett Packard Enterprise Labs Belgium, and Argotech a.s., with a budget of over €4.2 million.

STARLight: This European consortium, led by STMicroelectronics, focuses on silicon photonics (SiPho) technology for high-volume manufacturing of optical modules. The project targets datacenters, AI clusters, telecommunications, and automotive markets, developing photonic processors optimized for tensor operation...
