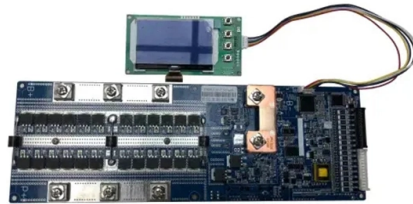

For example, a baud rate of 9600 means the signal changes 9600 times per second, affecting both speed and reliability of data transfer in industrial networks.
