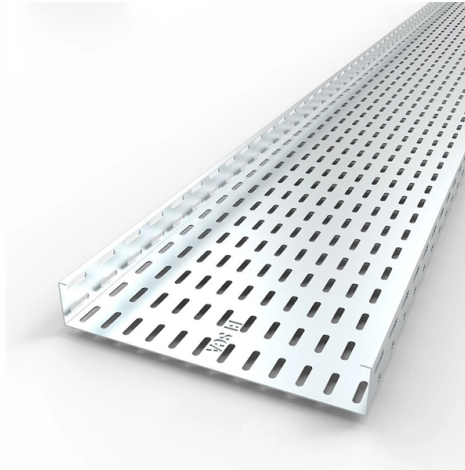

Internal Layout: Proper spacing and load calculation are essential. Electrical diagrams help map circuits, ensuring safe distribution and allowing for future expansion.

Applications

Residential and Commercial: Distributes power to lighting, appliances, and office equipment while isolating faults to individual circuits.

Industrial and Construction Sites: Handles high-current loads for machinery, tools, and temporary installations, often with multiple 230 V or 400 V outlets and RCD protection.

Utility-Scale PV Systems: Multi-circuit DC distribution boxes consolidate string-level protection, reduce cable runs, and improve fault response times. For example, 8-circuit DC boxes in a 100 MW PV project reduced cable length by 340 meters per combiner and cut copper costs by 18% while improving fault response from 12 minutes to under 90 seconds.
