- Front Panels:** Provide access to connectors and allow easy reconnection or expansion of active components like switches or media converters.

- Labeling and Color Coding:** Clearly mark cables to simplify maintenance and troubleshooting.
- Minimize Cable Lengths:** Avoid excessive slack to reduce signal loss and clutter.
- Defined Cable Paths:** Plan routes to prevent tangling and ensure easy access for future upgrades.
- Capacity Planning:** Reserve 20–30% extra ports for future expansion to avoid early replacement.

Material and Environmental Considerations

- Indoor Applications:** ABS plastic is lightweight and cost-effective.
- Outdoor/Industrial Applications:** SMC or ABS+PC materials provide higher UV resistance, impact durability, and limited weather tolerance.
- Ingress Protection (IP) Ratings:** Ensure the box is sealed against dust and moisture, critical for outdoor installations.
