

New National Standard Thickness Specifications for Galvanized Cable Trays



AI Overview

The latest national standard specifies steel tray thicknesses from 1.2mm to 3mm and zinc coating thicknesses of $\geq 12\mu\text{m}$ for electro-galvanized and $\geq 65\mu\text{m}$ for hot-dip galvanized trays.

Steel Tray Thickness According to the T/CECS 31-2017 standard, the steel thickness of cable tray components depends on the tray type and width:

- Side plates and rungs: Minimum 1.2mm for ladder trays with widths between 150mm and 400mm.
- Cover plates: Minimum 0.6mm for the same width range.
- For wider trays (500–800mm), steel bridge thickness should be 2.0mm, aluminum alloy $\geq 2.2\text{mm}$, and fiberglass $\geq 4.5\text{mm}$.

Typical tray sheet metal thickness ranges from 1.5mm to 3mm, with heavier components like brackets and supports often exceeding 3mm.

Zinc Coating Thickness The zinc coating thickness is determined by the galvanization method and environmental conditions:

- Electro-galvanized trays: Minimum zinc layer thickness $\geq 12\mu\text{m}$, suitable for indoor general corrosion environments.
- Hot-dip galvanized trays: Minimum zinc layer thickness $\geq 65\mu\text{m}$ (coating weight $\sim 460\text{ g/m}^2$ per side), suitable for outdoor or highly corrosive environments.

Hot-dip galvanizing provides superior bonding, durability, and maintenance-free protection compared to electro-galvanization.

Additional Requirements The galvanized coating must be continuous, uniform, and free of defects such as bare spots, blisters, or excessive zinc dross. Damaged areas in hot-dip galvanized trays must be repaired with compatible materials to maintain coating integrity. The coating thickness is measured both as local thickness (minimum at any point) and mean coating mass (average over the entire surface) to ensure compliance.

Summary For modern galvanized cable trays under national standards:

- Steel thickness: 1.2–3mm depending on tray type and width.
- Zinc coating: $\geq 12\mu\text{m}$ for electro-galvanized (indoor), $\geq 65\mu\text{m}$ for hot-dip galva...
