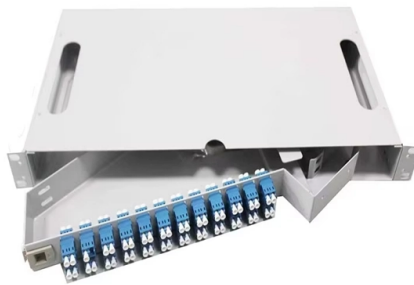


Non-standard PoE switches vs standard PoE switches

Standard PoE switches comply with IEEE standards and safely negotiate power with devices, while non-standard PoE switches deliver power without negotiation, posing potential risks to non-PoE devices.

Standard PoE Switches Definition and Operation: Standard PoE switches, also called active PoE switches, follow IEEE standards such as 802.3af (PoE), 802.3at (PoE+), and 802.3bt (PoE++). They provide both data and power over a single Ethernet cable to powered devices (PDs) like IP cameras, VoIP phones, and wireless access points. Before supplying power, these switches perform a handshake protocol to detect whether the connected device supports PoE. The PoE control chip ensures the voltage and power are compatible, preventing damage to non-PoE devices.

Advantages: Safe for all compliant devices, Prevents overvoltage or device damage, Supports multiple power levels (PoE, PoE+, PoE++), Compatible with modern network deployments.

Power Delivery: Standard PoE switches can deliver power over pins 1,2,3,6 (Mode A), pins 4,5,7,8 (Mode B), or all 8 pins (4-pair PoE) depending on the standard and device requirements.

Non-Standard PoE Switches Definition and Operation: Non-standard PoE switches, also known as passive or proprietary PoE, do not follow IEEE standards. They deliver power immediately over the Ethernet cable without performing a handshake or detection process. The voltage is "always-on," typically 48V or other proprietary levels, regardless of whether the connected device supports PoE.

Risks and Limitations: Can damage non-PoE devices if connected, Lack of negotiation may lead to overvoltage, Compatibility is limited to devices designed for the specific non-standard PoE.

Often cheaper but less safe for mixed-device networks.

Categories: Non-standard PoE includes passive PoE, proprietary PoE, and high-wattage proprietary PoE.
