- 3. Accessibility and Maintenance**
 - Position boxes where technicians can easily access splicing trays, patch panels, and connectors for installation, testing, and future expansion.
 - Ensure enough space for fiber slack to prevent bending or tensile stress, which can degrade signal quality.
- 4. Mounting Options**
 - Wall-mounted boxes:** Compact and suitable for indoor or small-scale deployments.
 - Rack-mounted ODFs:** Used in central offices or data centers for high-density fiber management.
 - Pole-mounted or street cabinets:** For outdoor distribution in FTTC/FTTP networks.
- 5. Network Density and Signal Management**
 - Higher-density areas may require larger or modular boxes to accommodate multiple fibers and splitters.
 - Proper labeling and structured routing inside the box help minimize signal loss and simplify troubleshooting.
