

Optimal Height for Indoor Cable Trays

Height Above Ground: Cable trays should ideally be installed at least 2.3 meters from the ceiling or any other obstructions. Cable tray (or cable ladder) systems are a popular alternative to electrical conduit systems, as they have an outstanding record for dependable service, design flexibility and cost savings in commercial and industrial applications. Prior to installing cable in the cable tray, examine cable paths to ensure all areas are free of debris that may interfere with the cable's installation. The cable tray should never be used as a walkway.
