- Water Protection:** IP3 provides only minimal water protection. Outdoor cabinets are usually exposed to rain, wind-driven water, or cleaning jets, which require a second digit of 5 or 6 (IP65 or IP66) to ensure safety and prevent corrosion or electrical hazards.
- Practical Recommendation:** For outdoor installations, an IP3-rated cabinet is insufficient. Most outdoor enclosures use IP65 as a standard, which is dust-tight and splash-proof, or IP66 for protection against powerful water jets. Choosing a higher IP rating also helps prevent condensation and moisture-related damage while balancing ventilation needs.
- Conclusion** An IP3-rated cabinet is generally not suitable for outdoor use, as it offers limited protection against dust and water. For reliable outdoor performance, especially in areas exposed to rain, dust, or cleaning procedures, IP65 or higher is recommended to ensure the safety and longevity of the equipment inside the cabinet.
