Key Grounding Principles

NEC and OSHA Requirements

- NEC Article 250 outlines grounding and bonding requirements, including sizing conductors, connecting to ground rods, and bonding metallic parts.
- NEC Article 411 specifically addresses low-voltage landscape lighting, requiring the transformer enclosure to be grounded and the line-voltage side protected.
- OSHA 1910.304 provides additional wiring design and protection standards for outdoor electrical installations, including clearances and conductor identification.

Practical Installation Guidelines

- Ground Rods and Resistance:** Use copper-bonded steel rods and ensure the total resistance to earth is 25 ohms or less. If resistance exceeds this, install multiple rods connected with a continuous conductor.
- Conductor Sizing:** Use appropriately sized copper conductors (e.g., 500 kcmil for high-current applications, 250 kcmil for standard connections) to connect the distribution box to the ground grid.
- Dedicated Ground Bar:** Install a dedicated ground bar inside the distribution box; avoid double-tapping neutrals to ensure a reliable fault path.
- Bonding Metal Components:** All metallic enclosures, conduit, and nearby conductiv...
