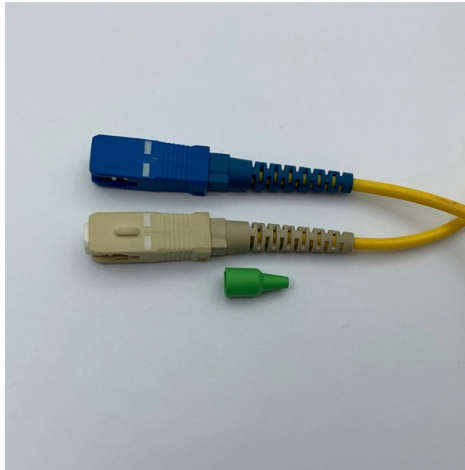

- Innerducts:** Subdividing ducts with innerducts can reduce fill ratios and pulling tension, facilitating future cable additions.
- Blowing or Air-Assisted Installation:** For microcables, high-speed airflow can reduce mechanical stress, allowing longer pulls without a shuttle or rope.
