

Precautions for laying pigtail fabric

4. Handle Bare Fiber Carefully The exposed fiber end is extremely fragile. Avoid touching it with fingers or letting it contact surfaces. Use proper fiber strippers and cleavers to expose the bare glass without causing micro-fractures that could lead to breakage .
5. Use Proper Splicing Techniques For fusion splicing, ensure the fiber ends are perfectly cleaved and aligned. Mechanical splicing requires precise alignment and clean surfaces. Using high-quality tools and following manufacturer instructions reduces insertion loss and back reflection .
6. Maintain a Clean Work Environment Perform splicing and connectorization in a clean, dust-free area. Even microscopic particles can compromise the splice quality and long-term reliability .
7. Dispose of Fiber Scraps Safely Fiber shards can cause injury if ingested or embedded in the skin. Use designated disposal units for fiber scraps to prevent accidents .
8. Avoid Excessive Tension Do not pull or stretch pigtails excessively during installation. Tension can damage the fiber or connectors, leading to signal degradation .
