Connection Points: Attach the flat iron connector to a threaded stud at the bottom of the distribution box housing, then connect it to the mounting plate. From the mounting plate, run a second grounding wire to the central grounding point.

Connector Type: Mechanical clamps or compression connectors are commonly used for industrial applications, providing visually verifiable, corrosion-resistant connections suitable for direct burial or heavy-duty installations.

Resistance Check: After installation, verify that the total ground resistance between all system parts is below 0.1 Ohm to ensure proper grounding performance.
