Sizing and Fill Limits Calculate tray width and depth based on the number and type of cables. Avoid overfilling:

- Power cables:** Maximum 40% of tray cross-sectional area.
- Control cables:** Maximum 50% of tray cross-sectional area.

Proper sizing prevents overheating and ensures long-term reliability.

Support and Mounting Secure trays using trapeze hangers, wall brackets, or ceiling supports. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load. Ensure trays are level, straight, and properly connected to prevent sagging or mechanical stress.
