- Airflow and Cooling:** Maintain proper spacing between devices to allow airflow and prevent overheating (). Avoid stacking equipment too tightly; leave gaps for ventilation and cooling fans to operate efficiently ().
- Identification and Documentation:** Number devices and cables for easy identification (). Maintain diagrams of equipment layout and cable routing to facilitate maintenance and future upgrades (). Use consistent labeling and color coding to distinguish between differe...
