 - Equipment Verification:** Ensure correct relay models, wiring, and installation.
 - Removal of Deliberate Earth Connections:** Disconnect earthing links on CTs, VTs, and DC supplies to prevent false readings.
 - Settings Verification:** Confirm relay settings manually or via software, with a second-person check recommended.
- Current and Voltage Transformer Checks**
 - Polarity and Phasing:** Verify CT and VT polarities and phasing using low-voltage DC tests and moving-coil ammeters.
 - Magnetization Curve Testing:** Measure CT knee-point voltage to ensure proper satu...
