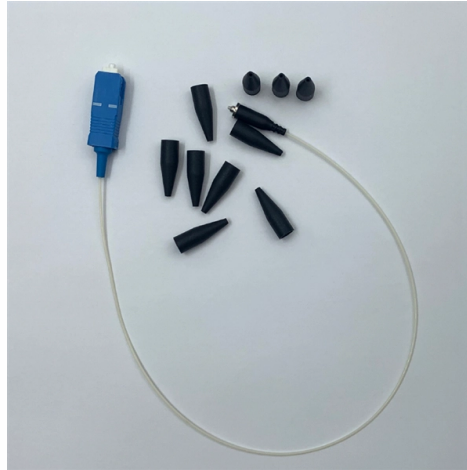


Safety Requirements for Main Distribution Boxes on Construction Sites

Separation of Circuits: Power distribution and lighting circuits should be separated within the box to prevent interference and enhance safety ().

Compliance and Maintenance Standards: Follow NEC, IEC, or local electrical codes, and use UL/CE-certified components ().
