

Secondary distribution box wiring lugs



AI Overview

Secondary distribution boxes (subpanels) use main or sub feed lugs to connect feeder wires and branch circuits safely and efficiently. Types of Lugs

- Compression Lugs:** These are crimped onto the wire using a matching die and provide a high-reliability connection with low resistance. They are often pre-filled with oxide inhibitors and can accommodate copper or aluminum wires up to 1000 MCM, making them suitable for high-current applications.
- Mechanical Lugs:** These lugs use screws or clamps to secure the wire. They are reusable, quick to install, and ideal for situations where connections may need to be adjusted or extended.
- Feed-Through or Sub Feed Lugs:** These allow a single feeder circuit to power multiple load centers. The incoming feeder connects to the top lugs, and the outgoing connection to the next panel is made via the bottom lugs, automatically energizing downstream panels.

Wiring Considerations

- Feeder Connections:** A subpanel is typically fed from the main panel using two hot wires (L1 and L2), a neutral, and a ground. The hot wires connect to the subpanel bus bars, the neutral to the neutral bus, and the ground to the ground bus.
- Neutral and Ground Separation:** In a subpanel, the neutral bus and ground bus must remain separate, unlike the main panel where they are bonded.
- Wire Sizing:** The wire gauge must match the amperage of the feeder breaker. For example, a 60A subpanel may use #6 AWG copper wire, but longer runs may require upsizing to reduce voltage drop.
- Breaker Selection:** The subpanel breakers should be sized according to the load requirements of each branch circuit, ensuring protection against overloads.
- Installation:** Lugs should be installed according to manufacturer instructions, ensuring proper torque and secure connections. Compression lugs require the correct die size for a reliable crimp, while mechanical lugs require proper tightening without over-compression.
