**Special Circuits:** Any additional circuits, such as bathroom outlets, water heaters, or dedicated equipment, should have separate switches to isolate faults without affecting other circuits.

**Bipolar or 1P+N Switches:** For single-phase circuits, use bipolar or phase + neutral air switches to ensure both lines are disconnected during a short circuit or leakage, enhancing safety for users and equipment.
